## Course Aims

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge for an individual to be competent in designing, developing and utilising basic multimedia briefs either as an independent ICT specialist or as part of a team.

## Characteristics of Learning Outcomes

Knowledge and competencies at this level cover a broad range of varied activities or applications in a wider variety of contexts most of which are complex and non-routine. Leadership and guidance are involved when organising activities of self and others as well as contributing to technical solutions of a non-routine or contingency nature.

Skills at this level involve performance of a broad range applications including evaluating and analysing current practices, developing new criteria and procedures for performing current practices, and provision of some leadership and guidance to others in the application and planning of the skills.

Application of skills involves responsibility for, and limited organisation of others.
